Dried milk, long life fruit juice/bottles of squash, jam (not homemade), sugar, sponge puddings, cleaning materials eg washing powder, washing up liquid, toiletries, including those for men, long life milk, instant mashed potato, bags for life. Other items are accepted, along with donations towards running costs, but please no baked beans or spaghetti - we have more than enough of these at present.
