LYCIG in Lent: Tuesday 7, 14 and 21 March 10.00 am at All Saints, repeated Wednesday 8, 15, and 22 March 7.30 pm at All Saints.

The LYCIG core group (Peter Aspin, Dot Bevington, Ian Birkinshaw, Ian Richardson, Joan Sargent, James Simister, Pauline Simmons, Heather Wraight, Juliet Wright) has met twice since our inspiring Parish Weekend with Bob Jackson. On 4 February we attended a York Diocesan LYCIG follow-up day, and on 8 February we met to consider the written feedback from the Parish Weekend and from discussions in some cell groups. The written comments helped us begin to identify priorities. The next step in the LYCIG process will be the *LYCIG in Lent* sessions—details above—which are designed to help everyone understand more of the LYCIG principles and strategies, and to give you an opportunity to help shape our *Mission Action Plan*.
