Following the successful *Let's Lunch* events in New Earswick Primary School at Christmas and Easter, we aim to put on a series of family events in New Earswick in the summer months—possibly outdoor games and a free barbecue on three(?) occasions. The PCC Buildings and Fabric working group is exploring ways to improve the All Saints refreshment area. Redevelopment at St Andrew's continues—a stair-case for the mezzanine level is currently under construction.
