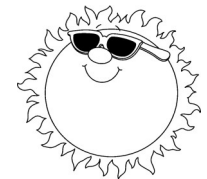






20 Mile Challenge Walk—from Annie
