Monday 12—Sunday 18 February

All Saints will be 'closed' during half-term week (apart from the Ash Wednesday service) while the kitchen facilities are upgraded. All units are to be replaced, a larger fridge added, a new hot water heater under the sink, and a new wall-mounted water boiler to the right of the serving hatch. Wall-mounted cupboards will be deeper and higher, and corner cupboards will be 'L-shaped', enabling easier access.
