
Refreshments are served after the 10.30 am services - please join us.

Our New Church Logo

We are phasing in a new church logo to replace the old 'handshake'. The PCC thought it would be helpful for everyone to know the thinking behind it. You will see it in two different forms—the standard logo, and a vertical version.

the triangle

- ▶ The shape—echoes the capital **A** of *All Saints and St Andrew's Church*.
- ▶ Represents God—Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- ▶ Three distinct parts make the whole—one God in three persons.
- ▶ The gaps—access to the centre where we're held within the love of God.
- ▶ Our mission and ministry in 3 directions—IN (loving one another), UP (loving God), and OUT (loving our community and the wider world)—reflecting our statement of purpose: *Knowing Jesus and making him known in our community and beyond*.
- ▶ Our parish with three villages—Huntington, Earswick and New Earswick.

the colours

- ▶ **Red Blue** and **Green**—the primary colours of light (1 John 1:5).
- ▶ **Green** for **God the Father**—life, growth, creation.
- ▶ **Red** for **Jesus Christ**—his blood shed for our salvation.
- ▶ **Blue** for the **Holy Spirit**—air, water.
- ▶ The colouring is textured to soften the geometrical design.

the words

- ▶ *All Saints and St Andrew's* **CHURCH**—to say exactly who we are.
- ▶ Emphasis on **ONE church** with two buildings.
- ▶ We retain the same font (*Century Gothic*) because the letter 'T' in **All Saints and St Andrew's Church** is then shaped like a cross.
