Refreshments are served after the 10.30 am services - please join us.

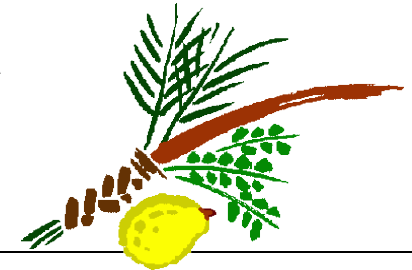
