There are always people available to pray with you - please ask.

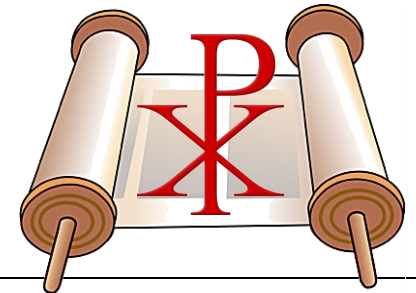
